General Guidelines for Members

- Members bringing guests to the club, are required by the Nova Scotia Liquor Licensing Board, as well as, by our Club rules, to register their guests in the guest book located at the bar.
- Persons may not be introduced as a guest more than 3 times in any one year. This includes any portion of our property, wharves and Clubhouse.
- Members and guests using the Club Facilities should be considerate and respectful of other users and staff.
- Members are responsible for their family and guests, and must accompany them during their visits to the club.
- Members are asked to respect the grounds of the facility by utilizing receptacles for garbage and recycling.

We have containers for garbage, recyclable and cardboard at the top of the driveway for disposable of your boating related garbage. These bins are not for household use.

- Staff has a right to refuse liquor service to any person in apparent violation of the law, and/or whenever a person is to the point of causing embarrassment or danger to staff, other members or guests, or to those outside the Club's premises.
- The responsibility for the operation of motor vehicles after consumption of alcoholic beverages lies with the individual member, or guest, and that responsibility is not, and will not be assumed by the club.
- Members are asked to respect the requirements of our Smoking Policy which indicates that there shall be no smoking inside of the Clubhouse, Learn to Sail Center, on the deck, or on the wharves.
- Shirts and footwear are to be worn at all times inside the Clubhouse.
- No Pets shall be permitted in the Clubhouse **or** on the decks. Members are responsible to ensure pets are on a leash AND UNDER EFFECTIVE CONTROL while on our property, as well as, for the proper collection and disposal of pet waste.
- Furnishings, Equipment, Pictures, trophies etc. are not to be removed from the Clubhouse without permission of the General Manager
- Please be respectful of our Staff, and General Managers time. They have full schedules, and are working for all of the members. Individual requests, on the spot, cannot always be accommodated.
